Paris, 26 August 2020 – Propel by MIPIM and MIPIM Urban Forum, the first events in the real estate, urban and innovation sector to take place in 2020, will provide an opportunity for everyone in the industry to get together and discuss major economic, ecological, social and, of course, health issues.
